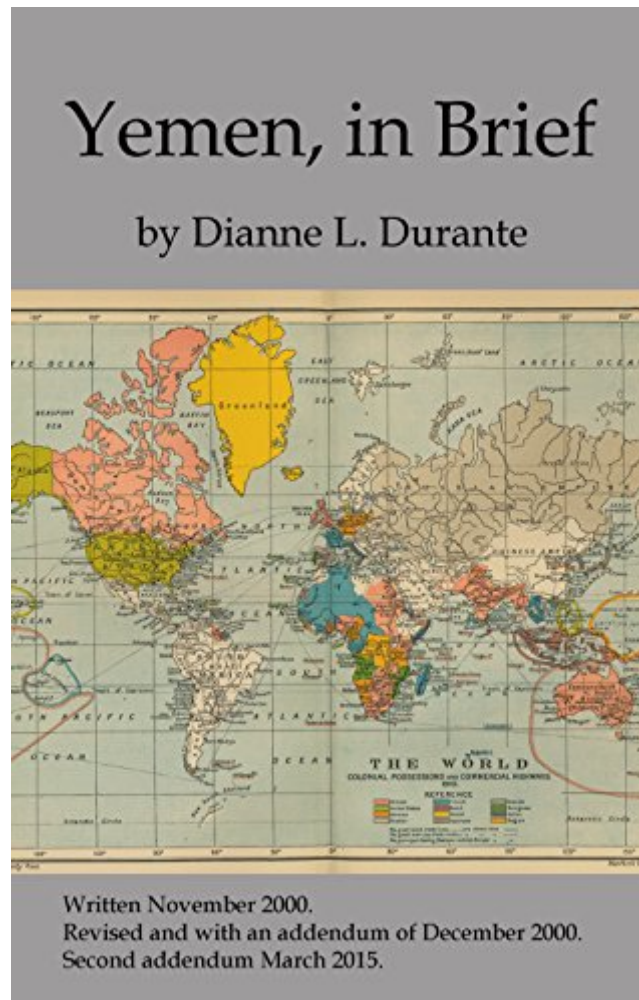

Synopsis
