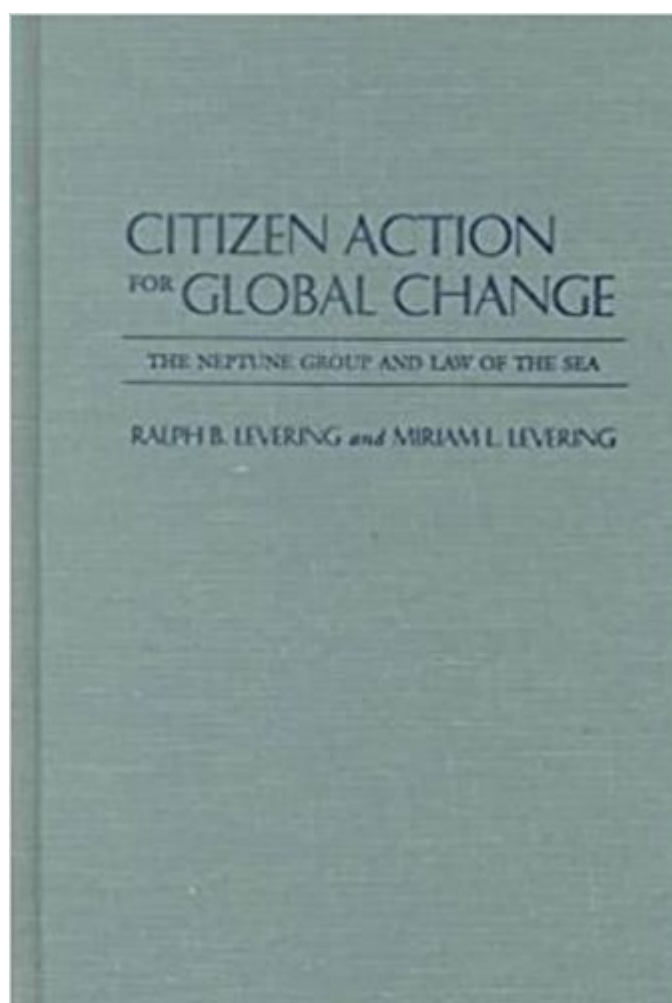


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Citizen Action For Global Change: The Neptune Group And Law Of The Sea (Peace And Conflict Resolution)
